

Minutes from FSC Spring Business Meeting 4/25/11

President, Nancy Quintero, called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Monday, April 25, 1022. In addition, officers Ashley Rogers, treasurer and Loni Rhea Hatfield, secretary were present, 31 members were present for the spring open meeting of the FSC.

Minutes were read and accepted by Loni Rhea, secretary.

Ashley Rogers gave the treasury reports with a beginning balance of \$5,882.89. Ending balance as of 4/25/11 was \$6,110.80.

Ann Matthews asked questions concerning the purchase of the bulbs. Nancy invested in different colored bulbs used for different parties. The bulbs are hard to find and purchasing in bulk reduced the cost from \$4 to \$1.25 per bulb.

The treasurer's report did not reflect earlier deposits made fro sale of S.O.S. cards.

The liquor bill from Fat Harold's was very high. Discussion was had regarding ways to control the cost.

Nancy suggested issuing wristbands in order to identify eligible members and guests. Suggestion was also made of deleting the free pitchers of alcohol. Another idea was only \$1.00 off ticket will be used and paid for ahead of time. Tickets could possibly also be used for soft drinks for those who didn't want alcohol.
